In some cases, grants of up to \$2,500 may be awarded to fund larger projects that involve the wider community or multiple schools. For proposals such as these, FAS may be able to provide staff for presentations or materials for instruction.

Examples of good proposals include, but are not limited to:

- A professional development workshop on First Amendment principles for your school's staff
- An "open house" for other schools in your area, showcasing your school's First Amendment-related best practices
- An event that supports civic-related student activities, such as a student council conference or mock trial competition
